When bringing items to the church for recycle, please be mindful that this is still a church and alcoholic container (glass or can) are prohibited **in/on** church premises.

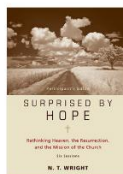
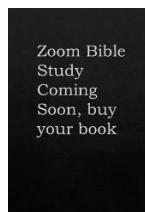
However, the QT (QuikTrip) across the street has a self-service recycle machines. If you choose, you may either bring the receipt or money to the church office and will be distributed accordingly.
