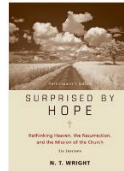
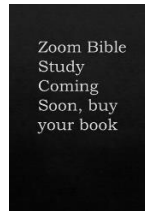
MEMBERSHIP CLASS
